



# SEBDOS



SEBDOS is a traded service which provides schools with support, advice and training to enable us to meet the needs of pupils with Social, Emotional and Behavioural difficulties.

The service aims to support schools to:

- Maintain a low percentage of fixed terms and exclusions compared with the national average
- Maintain high levels of pupils with SEBD needs in mainstream schools and with attendance at the same level as their peers
- Ensure that all pupils that are referred are provided with support and/or placed in appropriate settings within a reasonable time frame

The SEBD outreach service includes high quality and experienced practitioners from a range of educational backgrounds. Individual staff members have specific expertise relevant to work with early years, primary and secondary age pupils with social, emotional and behavioural difficulties. They work with pupils either individually or as part of a small group.

The SEBDOS team offer bespoke advice and consultation to school staff. It also offers support and training for teachers and teaching assistants around managing social, emotional and behavioural difficulties. The work of the team is focused on early intervention and the prevention of crisis for children, their families and schools.
