Each class elects two school councillors to put forward the contributions and suggestions of their class. The school council meets each week and shares their suggestions and ideas to make improvements to our school.



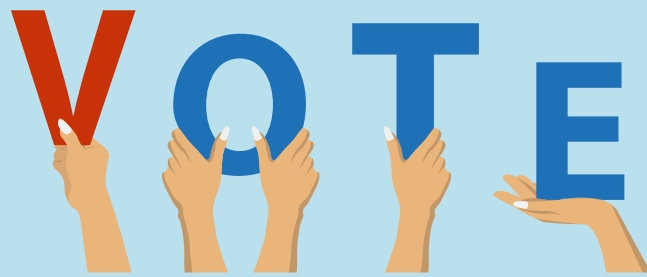
## PUPIL LEADERSHIP

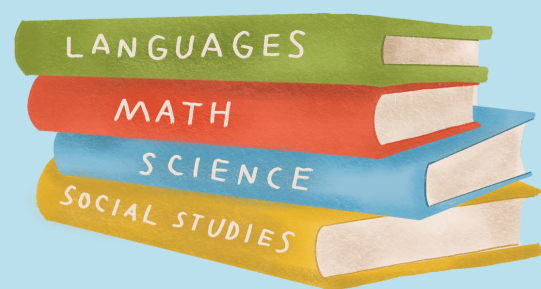


## BOUNCE TOGETHER SURVEYS

Each half term, our pupils complete a survey to share their honest thoughts about their mental health and wellbeing. We measure the outcomes and use this information to drive better outcomes for pupils and provide support.

## SUBJECT INTERVIEWS

Each week, subject leaders select a group of pupils to talk to about their learning. This gives our pupils an opportunity to express their views and feelings about their learning which subject leaders then respond to in order to drive improvement even further.



## R TIME

Pupils participate in a weekly session called R Time. A key focus of this is to develop pupils' confidence and social skills through partner work and discussion. This helps pupils to feel valued and to be resilient so that they can keep themselves mentally healthy.
