	<p>The Mental Health Support Team work closely with the school. They provide CPD for staff and support for both pupils and their families. The team regularly attend parents' evenings to support the community and work closely with our inclusion team to ensure pupils and families have access to the right support.</p>
	<p>Votes For Schools (VFS) is a valuable part of our curriculum offer to our pupils. VFS enables pupils to understand current affairs and provides an opportunity for them to share their views and opinions. Godolphin Junior Academy pupils who help lead VFS across the school are called VFS champions. Godolphin Junior Academy have won the national Student Pupils voice award twice and have been in second place twice.</p>
	<p>All our pupils receive expert delivered lessons from the Slough Music Service. The pupils thoroughly enjoy singing assemblies and learning to master different musical instruments from the ukulele to trombone.</p>
	<p>Godolphin Junior Academy are part of the LGfL EdTech Hubs which enables staff and pupils to be engaged with technology that is current and upcoming. Being a part of this hub means we share good practice and are provided with new services.</p>
	<p>Godolphin Junior Academy are a flagship school for Jigsaw PSHE. Through the scheme, our pupils learn British Values of respect, tolerance and equality and it contributes to SMSC (spiritual, moral, social and cultural) development. They learn to recognise and understand their own and others' emotions. These lessons are highly valued and help support our pupils to become responsible citizens.</p>
