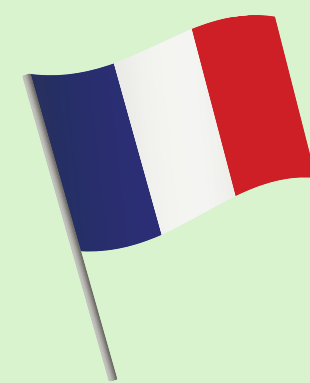

### FRENCH

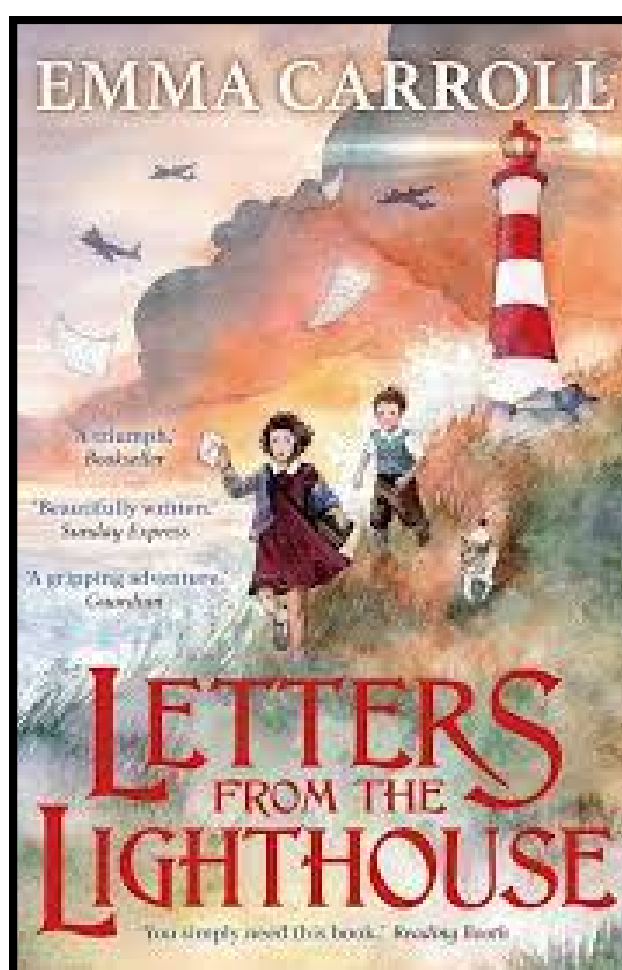


Our topic is 'descriptions'

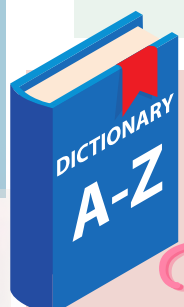
