

GJA Breakfast Club

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to say that Breakfast Club will run Monday-Friday from 8.00am. If you would like to book a place for your child to attend Breakfast Club then please download and complete a registration form from our website, or call the school office and ask for a form to be sent home with your child. Once you have completed and returned the form, you will be notified that your child has a place at breakfast club and the payment request will appear in your Parent Pay account.

Due to the health and safety protocols we have in place, we do need to request that every parent who would like a breakfast club place for their child completes the registration form. You can complete your form electronically and email it to gjaoffice@theparkfederation.org or you can return a hard copy by sending it in with your child.

How much does breakfast club cost?

Breakfast club costs £30.00 per pupil, per half term for those attending full time. This works out as £1.00 a day. You can choose to pay the £30.00 at the start of each half term, or if you prefer, you can pay weekly at £5.00 a week. If your child is attending on specific days then the charge is £1.00 for each day and this should be paid one week in advance.

What will my child have to eat?

At breakfast club we have a range of popular cereals, toast with butter or jam, fruit, yoghurts and fruit juice. There is something for everyone! The children can decide each morning what they would like to choose.

What time should my child arrive?

Your child can arrive between 8.00-8.15am and they should enter through the main gate at the front of the school. In the mornings, we would like parents to drop the children at the gate. The gate will close at 8.15am as this is the cut off time to arrive for breakfast club.

What activities will there be?

The children will be able to take part in active activities and e-learning activities. We have a rota in place so that one week it will be an active breakfast and the next week a computing breakfast.

What a great way to feel fit and fresh for the day and to also squeeze in some extra practice on Times Tables Rockstars or IXL!

As time progresses as we all settle back into school we are hoping to introduce even more activities to Breakfast Club.



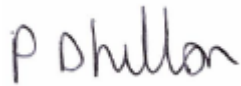
Will I receive any support if I am entitled to Pupil Premium funding?
